£2,450 DAIRY TOP

The gulf in prices between the strong milky dairies and the frail cattle is becoming wider.

The best heifers sold to £2,450 and £2,400 from MW & JM Trevor-Jones, Oswestry and £2,300 RA & JE Williams & Son, Hay-on-Wye and £2,050 HS & A Callwood, Knutsford.

Other heifers sold to £1,850 from Skinner Bros, Melton Mowbray.

MW & JM Trevor-Jones, Oswestry also topped the cows with a second calver at £2,100.

D & E Monk, Ormskirk sold a second calver for £1,900 and a seventh calver for £1,750.

The entry included a number of mid lactation dispersal cows and grazing type cattle with served heifers to £950 and heifer calves to £115.

A Beef Shorthorn stock bull (69 months) sold for £1,520 and a Hereford (18 months) £1,280.
