A fantastic entry forward selling on a very fast trade which was even more pleasing with the amount of heifers on offer. The entry consisted as usual of mixed breeds and variety from Calves to In Calf Heifers.

A special entry was the dispersal of the pedigree Jersey herd belonging to Whiteoaks Farming of Walton on Trent. They topped at £1,350 for Whiteoaks Disco Nonette who calved early August, with 18 of the 29 milkers selling for over £1,000.

In Calf Heifers from the same home sold to £1,020. The In Calf Heifer section topped at £1,610 from R.J.&J.E. Hall of Market Drayton for a 30 month old heifer which was 5 months in calf. They sold a further 8 for over £1,220. Recently served heifers sold to £890 for a Fleckvieh from Mr O. Bonell, Audlem.

Bulling Heifers were also very high in demand with anything well conditioned selling from £800 to £950. Top spot went to A.&J. Richardson, Byley at £960, who held the dispersal of their youngstock today. Another consignment of bullers from Messrs Crank, Tarporley topped at £950. Cross Bred Bulling Heifers met an improved trade, selling to £800 from Croenllwm Ltd, Denbigh. Yearling Heifers were a mixed entry of quality but all breeds sold very well. Top spot was £760 for a commercial heifer from Mr J. Boardman, Tarporley. Also worthy of a mention is the 8 month pedigree heifer Cotton Abbotts Mission May who sold for £710 from CE.&A. Walley, Chester who also sold weaned calves to £480, of which there were 57 in total and trade was very strong with plenty of interest.
