The quality of today's cows was exceptional with a trio of second calvers from Hankins Heys Farm, Audlem averaging £3,183 with a top of £3,400 and the other two making £3,150 and £3,000.

Other second calvers from KJ Morris, Worcestershire sold at £2,900, £2,750 and £2,600, R & R Vernon & Sons, Burleydam £2,550.

The best of the calved heifers peaked at £3,200 from M Weaver, Stone.

The overall quality of this week's heifers was a little disappointing with the next best at £2,650 from R & J Merrett, Gloucester. MT Jones, Oswestry sold at £2,620, R & J Merrett £2,580, LF Horton & Sons, Northwich £2,520 and £2,450, R & R Vernon & Sons £2,400, RW & EE Edwards & Sons, Hanmer £2,350 and £2,300, AC Hocknell & Sons, Whitchurch £2,320, Hankins Heys Farm £2,250, OC Whittaker & Sons, Knutsford £2,100.
