THE BEST AGAIN VERY DEAR – 6 OVER £3,000 £3,400 HEIFER – £3,320 COW

The best were very dear again with Shutt & Mansell, Flashbrook topping both sections for the second week running. Their fresh heifers sold at £3,400 and £3,280 and their cows £3,320 for a second calver and £3,000 for a third calver. All four of their cattle averaged £3,250.

Heavy milking young cows were in great demand with others at £3,150 and £2,820 from JE Milner, Stoke-on-Trent, both of which were second calvers. Wilkinson Brothers, Northwich sold a fourth calver at £2,580, Grosvenor Farms, Chester sold second calvers at £2,520 and £2,400, and J Lomax & Son, Baldwins Gate sold a fourth calver at £2,400.

Other leading prices for fresh heifers were £3,050, £2,950 and £2,720 from LF Horton & Sons, Northwich, £2,800 Grosvenor Farms.

In-calf Heifers sold to £2,000. Heifer calves to £220. Hereford stock bull (22 months) £2,020.

In all there were 10 cattle over £2,700.
